O WHY?

Choose a cause you are passionate about because during your fundraising you will talk about it a lot. Do you want to help refugees or give to an emergency? Or do you want to raise for a water well as Sadaqah Jariyah for a deceased relative? Find your why! This will be your biggest motivator in your fundraising journey.

2 HOW MUCH?

FUNDRAISING PAGES

We recommend setting up a Fundraising page (and not a Crowdfunding page) on **JustGiving**. How to do this is explained on the next page. Unlike some other platforms JustGiving does not charge a platform fee on any individual donation made to us. Instead, they give donors the option to make a voluntary contribution to the cost of maintaining their platform. Funds collected through JustGiving will be automatically transferred to Muslim Hands, by JustGiving on your behalf.

CHEQUE OR POSTAL ORDER

You can send your donation via cheque or postal order. Please make them payable to 'Muslim Hands' and send them to our London office. Make sure you let us know the name of your Fundraiser and Donor ID.

PHONE

You can deposit the funds raised and donate over the phone using your credit or debit card by calling our donation hotline on 0115 911 7222.

BANK TRANSFER

You can transfer the funds directly into our donations account.

Please reference the donation with your Donor ID and the name of your Fundraiser. Please also note that receipts cannot usually be issued for donations made via bank transfer.



- Head to justgiving.com/muslimhands and select 'Fundraise for us', then sign in or create an account.
- Select the type of activity you are doing for your fundraiser. If you are unsure, select 'Doing your own thing'.
- You will then be asked to fill in some further details about your activity, create your fundraising page URL and decide some other settings. Once you have completed the necessary steps, click the 'Create your page' button.
- Now you can personalise your fundraising page by adding more information about what you are doing and why. Select 'Edit your page' to add images, change your fundraising target and add to your story. During your fundraising journey, you can revisit this part of the page to post updates and share them on social media.
- In the 'Story' section of your page, please include this line: 'This is a fundraiser in aid of Muslim Hands'.
- Your fundraising page has now been created and you can begin sharing with friends, family and on social media. With your page linked to Muslim Hands, you don't need to worry about the transfer of funds, as JustGiving will process these on your behalf directly to us.

Please note: Fundraisers are responsible for organising all aspects of their fundraising and Muslim Hands will not accept any liability related to their fundraising.


Keep the donations coming!

You have started fundraising, the first donations have come in. But now they have started to come in slower and you fear they might stop coming it altogether. Here are some tips how you can get your fundraiser unstuck!

Make sure you explain your WHY? HOW MUCH? WHAT? WHO? and WHEN? clearly and briefly on your fundraising page and social media. Your summary should be so simple that you could explain the basics in 30 seconds to someone you meet.

<u>Update everyone regularly:</u> When you hit a new milestone towards your target, share a progress photo, share more information about your cause, thank your donors, ask your donors to share your fundraising page with their friends and family, tag Muslim Hands in your pictures so we can give your fundraiser a shoutout.

<u>Directly</u> ask friends and family to share your fundraiser! This one seems obvious but many do not do this enough because they dont want to pester anyone. Remember, there is a reward in leading others to do good! So keep asking for support for your cause.
