2009 - Gaza Winter Walk Is Born

The first walk in London raised £35,000 for food and medicine distributions and 6 hospitals equipped with supplies. Supported the reconstruction of the Islamic University of Gaza and income generation projects.

2011 - 2500 Children Receive **Psychosocial Support**

2500 children suffering from trauma and anxiety given psychosocial support. MH supported the expansion of the emergency department and construction of the pharmacy.







2010 – Medical Clinics Established

Over £50,000 raised to build MH Psychological Rehabilitation Centre and Mobile Health Clinic, Gaza War in 2009 destroyed Al-Durrah hospital and reconstructed again.

2013 - Winter Walk Hits Over The £100,000 Mark!

£111,000 was raised from London and Manchester to allow the Al-Durrah Hospital to help 54,784 children, Mobile Medical Clinic provided 7,800 health checks and Psychological Rehabilitation Centre has helped 3.187 cases.

2014 - Winter Walk Reaches Over £150.000

2,000 supporters all over the UK braved the cold and raised £157,000 for our long standing health projects in Gaza.

2015 - Gaza Blockade means Gaza **Winter Walk Gets Bigger And** Better

GWW came to 9 cities raising £143,000 in response to the conflict in summer 2014. Over 2,200 killed, nearly 500 were innocent children, 20,000 homes destroyed leaving 500,000 Gazans displaced.

2017 - Record Breaking Funds Raised - Over £273,000

MH partnered with UNRWA experts in providing maternal and child care to 132.000 Palestinian women and their children







2016 - Rebuilding Progress

The Gaza blockade in 2014 meant work previously carried out was either severely damaged or destroyed. In response £140,000 raised to rebuild the Al-Durrah Hospital and continue to support the wounded.
