

# The Cause: A Borehole in Somalia

## WATER IS AN ESSENTIAL PART OF ALL LIFE.

The reality is that 783 million people worldwide do not have access to clean water. With over 800,000 people dying from water-related illnesses each year, unsafe water is the single biggest obstacle to the progression and health of communities in the developing world.

### BOREHOLE IN CENTRAL SOMALIA

According to the World Bank, only 7% of the rural population in Somalia has access to improved water sources. Drought, conflict, displacement and constant instability have left large numbers of people in Somalia without clean water. Waterborne diseases are rife amongst children.

The current situation in this area is that there is no suitable water source available. There is an urgent need for these kinds of water projects in central Somalia.

**Beneficiaries:** over 20,000 families and their livestock.

**Project details:** The proposal is to construct a deep borehole which is over 100 metres deep. The borehole will be connected to a 24,000-litre water tanker.

## How to handle your donations

### CHEQUE OR POSTAL ORDER:

You can also bring the donation bucket to either our London or Nottingham office, just give our team a call beforehand and check our website for our office opening hours. Please do not send cash through the post.

You can transfer the funds directly into the Muslim Hands bank account.




Use your sponsorship form and get your friends and family to sponsor you.




## 5. Sell cupcakes

Ask your local mosque if they can make a Jummah/ Taraweeh announcement for you and if you could collect funds after the prayer.




## 7. Set up a donation box

Create a JustGiving page and ask all your contacts and everyone on all your social media sites to donate.




## 2. Organise an Iftar
