Around £57,000 was given on this virtual walk – to repair shelters for Gazan refugees. Subhan Allah, it was truly amazing to see everyone staying connected for a good cause during lockdown!

SNOWDON CHALLENGE

Our first live event of 2021 had such an amazing response that we had to invite you twice. In the summer, you raised £135,000 for Gaza; and in the autumn, you raised £22,000 for our Syrian bread factory.

Planting trees

This year alone, you planted over 67,000 olive trees in Palestine, as well as over 2,290 fruit trees elsewhere. This amazing Sadaqah Jariyah is not only providing food and livelihoods to farmers, it is also purifying the air, stabilising the soil and providing nourishment to wildlife.

Giving water

You continued to build water wells, solar-powered boreholes and rainwater harvesting systems, providing clean water in an environmentally-friendly way. SubhanAllah, you gave this lifechanging gift to over 270,000 people, transforming whole communities.



Helping orphans

You sponsored over 4,100 orphans this year! Ma sha Allah, for the first time, we could offer sponsorships in Yemen and Somalia – and we even opened a new school in Yemen! You are giving these children the resources to fulfil their potential and break the cycle of poverty, in sha Allah.

Aladdin is a farmer living near Hebron in Palestine. As a father of eight, he is constantly worried about not being able to cultivate his land to provide for his children. He fears that his land will be confiscated and he is also concerned about drought and lack of water.

By giving him olive trees, you have not only protected his land, you have also given his family a source of income and food. The olives and olive oil will cover their needs throughout the year, while any surplus crops can be sold to help them pay for other vital expenses.

Our team told us that, like many other Palestinian farmers, Aladdin has a strong love for olive cultivation. He is extremely grateful that he can continue to make a living from his land while providing for his family.

Ma sha Allah, we learned so much while preparing this collection and we hope you benefitted from this knowledge too.


