# How to handle your donations

**Once you have collected your donations, here are ways you can transfer the funds safely to us:**



## **CHEQUE OR POSTAL ORDER:**

You can send your donation via cheque or postal order.

Please make them payable to **'Muslim Hands'** and send them to our Nottingham office.

Cheques must be drawn on a UK bank account and postal orders should be obtained from the Post Office.



## **CASH:**

You can also bring the donation bucket to either our **London or Nottingham office**, just give our team a call beforehand and check our website for our office opening hours.

Please do not send cash through the post.



## **PHONE:**

You can make a payment over the phone using your credit or debit card by calling our donation hotline on **0115 911 7222**.



## **BANK TRANSFER:**

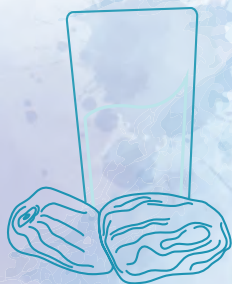

Use your sponsorship form and get your friends and family to sponsor you.

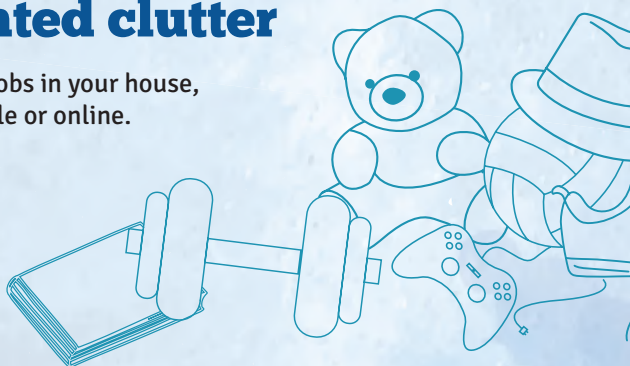


# 2. Organise an Iftar

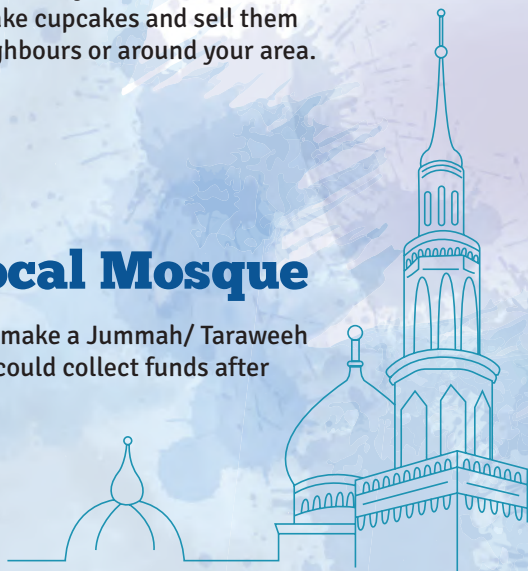
## 5. Sell cupcakes
